

## Becker declares Thursday 'One World, Everybody Eats' day

On Monday, Salt Lake City Mayor Ralph Becker signed a proclamation declaring October 16th World Food Day.

That means some downtown restaurants will offer a special food item that you price yourself. A portion of the profits will go to food charities.

Denise Cerreta is a big supporter of this event. Her community kitchen called "One World Everybody Eats" always allows people price their own meals, or even pay with volunteer work.

"We're trying to find a way to end food waste by allowing people to choose their own portions and price their own meals," said Cerreta.
